SQUARE RIGGER CLUB CHARITY CHARTERS 2018

The Square Rigger Club Charity is proudly associated with TS Royalist and the Sea Cadets and generously provides bursaries and occasional items of equipment. In return, there is an opportunity of taking part in at least two adult charters each year organised by the Square Rigger Club Charity, which are greatly enjoyed by Club members and like minded people, who want to enjoy the experience of sailing in a traditional square rigger.

The Square Rigger Club Charity has conducted many charters through the years and these charters are always convivial, fun and dare we say, instructional and can be taken at any level of seriousness according to each individual's choice. The voyages offer hands on participation in every aspect of the ship's life, be it steering the ship, setting sail, standing watch or helping feed the hungry crew as well as providing an opportunity to experience the vessel and determine if you would like to train as a member of the Afterguard (subject to suitable qualifications) in order to join the relief staff cadre to assist on TS Royalist cadet voyages. The charter's profit goes directly towards TS Royalist, providing bursaries for Sea Cadets and essential extras for the ship.

There are two charters during 2018. The first charter is in April and the second one is in October and during the weekend the ship will sail wherever wind and weather conditions permit! The April charter starts and finishes in the lovely little port of Dartmouth. The prospect of sailing down the Cornish Coast, perhaps even as far as the Scilly Isles is an option. The second charter is from the home port of Gosport and previous charters from Gosport have regularly visited France and the Channel Isles. The great advantage of sailing from the Solent is that the ship will most likely be able to sail in the sheltered waters whatever ever the weather wishes to do! Interested? Charter from Dartmouth to Dartmouth - Friday 13th - Monday 16th April 2017

Those who wish to join this charter will need to travel to Dartmouth by their own arrangements on Friday, 13th April to arrive at the ship no later than midday. The charter will finish back in Dartmouth on Monday, 16th April and participants will depart by midday. if you require parking for your car, there are private car parks or by arrangement parking in off-road driveways. Solent charter from Gosport to Gosport - Friday 5th October - Monday 8th October 2018

Those who wish to join this charter will need to travel to Fort Blockhouse, Gosport by their own arrangements on Friday, 5th October to arrive at the ship no later than midday . The charter will finish back in Gosport on Monday, 8th September and participants will depart by midday. There is secure parking near the ship at Fort Blockhouse but those that arrive by train would travel to Portsmouth Harbour and take the ferry across to Gosport with a walk or taxi ride to Fort Blockhouse.

General Information

At the time of arrival at the ship, a light lunch of sandwiches and fruit will be available. On occasion, when TS Royalist is in some interesting port or anchorage, some crew members may wish to eat ashore but there is always a meal available on board for those who may just want to have a drink ashore after eating on board or just stroll around the port.

A full kit list will be sent out nearer the time of departure but wet weather gear and lifejackets are provided by TS Royalist. Final details will be advised not later than six weeks before the date of embarkation.

SRCC Charter Terms & Conditions

Charter Fees: The fee for the April 2018 charter will be £345 for club members and £395 for non members. Payment will be made in two parts (an initial deposit and balance six weeks before departure).

The fee for the September 2018 charter will be £345 for club members and £395 for non members. Payment will be made in two parts (an initial deposit and balance six weeks before departure).

Deposit: A non returnable deposit of £125 per person for each charter is to be paid at the time of booking. This will be acknowledged by letter or email, which will also confirm the allocation of a berth.

Balance: April Charter, Final payment of £220 (Members) or £270 (Non Members) due by 1st March. October Charter, Final payment of £220 (Members) or £270 (Non-Members) must be paid by 20th August.

Age: Minimum age is eighteen years. There is no maximum age for participation in SRCC charters. Participants over seventy five years old are most welcome but need to request and complete a Declaration of Fitness form.

Physical Ability: Although there is no maximum age a normal level of fitness is required. In the interests of safety you must be able to climb (in an emergency) a 12ft high vertical ladder in a lively motion. All medical conditions and details of medicines currently being taken must be reported to the Coxswain prior to departure.

Going Aloft: Going aloft is not mandatory, however in order for everyone to enjoy sailing a square rigger, 50% of the crew will be required to go aloft in all conditions. Please indicate on your application your willingness to go aloft.

Communal Duties: As you provide the working crew for the ship, as part of a watch you will be required to undertake the following tasks:

Mess Duty: On an allocated day, serve your fellow crew members and afterguard crew with their meals and wash up when the meal is complete.

Clean Ship: Clean and tidy a part of the ship allocated to you.

Stand watch: As a member of a watch you will be expected to stand watches and act as look out and helmsman.

Food preparation: Assist in preparation of vegetables for the galley and layout table for meals.

Members: Please complete the Application Form and return it with your deposit of £125 per person charter to the Charter Secretary. Cheques should be made payable to the SQUARE RIGGER CLUB CHARITY. The Joining Instructions will be sent out no later than six weeks before the date of departure.

Non-Members: We invite you to join the Square Rigger Club Charity and take advantage of savings in member rates for the charters. It's easy to join immediately on line or complete a Membership Application Form (available from our website) and send it together with your deposit to the Charter Secretary. The member rates are available only to new members who join online and pay their subscription by Direct Debit.

Insurance: Charter participants travel and take part in SRCC charters at their own risk and it is recommended that you consider insurance for your own protection.
